

## Africa and Latin America - The Case for No Change in 470-698 MHZ at WRC-15

The European Broadcasting Union (EBU) issued 2 infographics (<u>Africa</u> and <u>Latin America</u>) making the case for the 'no change' position in 470-698 MHZ at the upcoming WRC-15, and explaining why the mobile industry does not need more UHF spectrum.

These include the underutilization of spectrum allocated to mobile, risks of cross Border and local interference and overestimated needs (incorrect assumptions and a questionnaire that was answered by only 3 countries in Region 2 and only 14 in the whole world).

Among other cases for the 'no change', Africa also highlights the cost efficiency of wifi and the risks changes would entail for the content sector, job creation and citizens access to communications.
